



## From M62 Westbound

- Exit the M62 at Junction 24 and follow the signs for Halifax (A629), through a large roundabout staying on the A629 for Halifax down a long descent on the dual carriage way.
- At the end of the dual carriage way take the left turn at the traffic lights for Sowerby Bridge.
- Down the hill for 50 yards and straight on at the mini roundabout.
- This takes you past the 'Halifax' Building Society Offices on the right hand side.
- At the end of the road is a T Junction, take the left turn into Sowerby Bridge.
- At the traffic lights by the Church, turn right up Tuel Lane to the A646. This will take you up a very steep hill.
- At the top of the hill turn left onto the A646 heading towards Hebden Bridge.
- Proceed for about 4 miles until you come to Mytholmroyd.
- At the first set of traffic lights, take the left turn onto New Road. Over the river bridge towards Littleborough.
- After passing under the railway bridge take the next left turn onto Scout Road (signed Sowerby) and then immediately left into Orchard Business Park.
- JVL Products offices are at the end of the park on the right hand side.

## From M62 Eastbound

- Exit the M62 at Junction 21 (signed Milnrow)
- At the roundabout at the bottom of the slip road take the first exit, onto the A640 (Milnrow)
- At the traffic lights take a right turn onto the B6225. At the mini roundabout take the first exit up the Kiln Lane. At the top of the hill turn left just before The Gallows (a public house)
- At the end of this road is a mini roundabout. Turn right and follow this road past the lake until you come to a T Junction with the A58
- At the T Junction turn right on to the A58 (signed Halifax)
- Proceed along the A58 for about 2.5 miles
- On the left is a reservoir. Turn left immediately after onto the B6138 towards Mytholmroyd
- Carry on down the B6138 for about 5.6 miles. After passing a Library on your right, take a right turn onto Scout Road and then immediately left into Orchard Business Park
- JVL Products offices are at the end of the park on the right hand side.
